An Ordinance Amending the City Code  
with respect to the Zoning Ordinance

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE:

Section 1. That, Chapter 23, Section 23-8, of the Code of the City of Charlotte is hereby amended by changing from R-12 to R-12 MF on the Official Zoning Map, City of Charlotte, N. C. and Perimeter Area the following described property:

Being all of lot 21 in block 1, lot 19 and 20 in block 3 of Laurelwood as recorded in map book 9 at page 497 in the Mecklenburg Public Registry and being all of lots 22 and 23 in block 4 and lot 3 in block 6 of Laurelwood as recorded in map book 9 at page 499 in the Mecklenburg Public Registry.

Section 2. That, this ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.

An Ordinance Amending the City Code  
with respect to the Zoning Ordinance

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE:

Section 1. That, Chapter 23, Section 23-8, of the Code of the City of Charlotte is hereby amended by changing from R-6MFH to B-1 on the Official Zoning Map, City of Charlotte, N. C. and Perimeter Area the following described property:

Beginning at a point in the northwesterly margin of Kenilworth Avenue said point being located 200.0 feet southwest of the southwesterly margin of East Boulevard and running thence with said margin of Kenilworth Avenue S.40-43-45W. 150.0 feet; thence N.47-15W. 144.09 feet more or less to a point in the southeasterly margin of Charlotte Drive; thence with said margin of Charlotte Drive in a northeasterly direction 150.0 feet; thence S.47-15E. 144.09 more or less to the point of beginning.

Section 2. That, this ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.


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BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina:
