Section 1. That, Chapter 23, Section 23-8, of the Code of the City of Charlotte is hereby amended by changing from R-9 & I-1 to I-2 on the Official Zoning Map, City of Charlotte, N. C. and Perimeter Area the following described property:

BEING two tracts located east of Oakdale Road, south of Auten Road, and north of Black Satchel Road, as shown on the attached map.


Section 2. That, this ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.

ORDINANCE NO. 511-X

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 255-X, SECTION 1, SCHEDULE A, OF THE 1969-70 BUDGET ORDINANCE, AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF A PORTION OF THE APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURCHASING AND CENTRAL SERVICES DEPARTMENTS INTO PUBLIC SERVICE AND INFORMATION BUDGET.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina:

Section 1. Ordinance Number 255-X, Section 1, Schedule A, is hereby amended by deleting the figures \$78,832 from the Purchasing Department appropriation, \$352,770 from the Central Services appropriation, \$26,840 from Public Service and Information, and substituting in lieu thereof the following words and figures: Purchasing Department, \$74,832; Central Services, \$349,770; Public Service and Information, \$33,840.
