WHEREAS, G.S. 20-141 (speed restrictions) requires adoption of a speed limit ordinance to amend Chapter 14, Section 131(c) of the Charlotte City Code,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte,

SECTION 1: That Schedule X referred to in Chapter 14-131(c) of the Charlotte City Code be amended by declaring a speed limit on the following City System street(s) as described below:

- **Browne's Creek Road from cul-de-sac to cul-de-sac** **25 MPH**
- **Dovefield Road from Woodview Circle to cul-de-sac** **25 MPH**

- **Haybridge Road from Hubbard Road to dead end** **25 MPH**
- **Kennel Lane from Boykin Spaniel Road to cul-de-sac** **25 MPH**
- **Quail Acres Road from Dovefield Road to Providence Road West** **25 MPH**
- **Symphony Woods Drive from Radbourne Boulevard to 390 feet of Nyewood Court** **25 MPH**

- Westminster Place from Sharon Road to Briarcliff Road 25 MPH
- Whistley Green Drive Radbourne Boulevard to cul-de-sac 25 MPH
- Woodview Circle from Providence Road West to cul-de-sac 25 MPH







ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE ENTITLED LICENSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE THAT:

Section 1. Section 13-36(a) is hereby amended by deleting the first sentence of said section in its entirety and substituting in lieu thereof the following: "Each motor vehicle licensed by the state which is resident within the City on January 1 of each year shall be subject to an annual privilege tax of thirty dollars (\$30); provided at least ten dollars (\$10) of said tax per year per vehicle shall be dedicated to and may be expended only for public mass transit systems and mass transit-related activities."

Section 2. Section 13-36(b) is hereby amended by deleting the words and figures "twelve dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50)" and substituting in lieu thereof the words and figures "fifteen dollars (\$15)"; and by deleting the words and figures "twenty five dollars (\$25)" and substituting in lieu thereof the words and figures "thirty dollars (\$30)".

Section 1. That the sum of \$1,500 is hereby available from a contribution from Carowinds for the Police Awards Program and is appropriated to Community Relations (0101;104.00.199).

Section 2. That the sum of \$1,500 is hereby available from contributions from Operation Blessing in honor of slain Police officers and for troubled youth and is appropriated to Neighborhood Services (0101;117.00.199).

Section 3. That the sum of \$30,000 is hereby estimated to be available from Mecklenburg County (\$25,000) and NC Department of Transportation (\$5,000) for an Emergency Management Mobile Command Post and is hereby appropriated to the General Fund (0101;401.45).

Section 4. That the sum of \$78,340 is hereby estimated to be available from Mecklenburg County and is hereby appropriated to the General Fund- Finance Department-Revenue Division.

Section 5. That the sum of \$3,100,951 is hereby estimated to be available from the following sources and is hereby appropriated to the General Fund for the addition of police officers. This project will extend past the end of this fiscal year; therefore this section shall remain in effect for the duration of the project.

Section 29. That the sum of \$280,628 previously estimated to be available in the General Fund for transfer to the CityFair Debt Service Fund is hereby appropriated to the CityFair Operating Fund, where it is hereby appropriated for transfer to the CityFair Debt Service Fund.

Section 30. That Ordinance 3585-X Section 3, Schedule P is hereby amended as follows:




