




AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FUNDS FOR ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES AND

ORDINANCE NO. 337-X

AN ORDINANCE ORDERING THE REMOVAL OF WEEDS AND GRASS PURSUANT TO SECTION 6.103 and 6.104 OF THE CITY CHARTER, CHAPTER 10, ARTICLE I, SECTION 10-9 OF THE CITY CODE AND CHAPTER 160-200 OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF NORTH CAROLINA

Section 1.

WHEREAS, weeds and grass located on the premises at (address) Adj. to 5101 Central Ave. has been found to be a nuisance by the Supervisor of Community Improvement Division of the Public Works Department, and the owner or those responsible for the maintenance of the premises has been ordered to remove the same pursuant to Chapter 10, Article I, Section 10-9 of the Code of the City of Charlotte: and

WHEREAS, the owner (s) or those person (s) responsible for the maintenance of these premises have failed to comply with the said order served by registered mail on October 12, 1971: and

WHEREAS, The City Council upon consideration of the evidence finds as a fact that the aforesaid premises are being maintained in a manner which constitutes a public nuisance because of weeds and grass

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED By the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, that the Supervisor of the Community Improvement Division of the Public Works Department is hereby ordered to cause removal of weeds and grass from the aforesaid premises in the City of Charlotte, and that the City assess costs incurred, and this shall be a charge against the owner, and shall be a lien against this property, all pursuant to Chapter 10, Article I, Section 10-9 of the Code of the City of Charlotte.

AMENDING SEC. 4.61
OF THE CITY CHARTER

ORDINANCE 339-X

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4.61 OF THE CITY CHARTER BY INCREASING THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE BOARD FROM THREE MEMBERS TO FIVE MEMBERS.

WHEREAS, Article 7 of Chapter 160A of the North Carolina General Statutes authorizes City Council to change offices, positions, departments, boards, commissions and agencies of City government in order to promote orderly and efficient administration of city affairs; and


WHEREAS, City Council is desirous of increasing the membership of the Charlotte Civil Service Board from three (3) members to five (5) members in order to promote orderly and efficient administration of city affairs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte that:

Sec. I. Section 4.61 of the City Charter is hereby amended by deleting the word "three" as it relates to the number of members of the Civil Service Board, and substituting in lieu thereof the word "five".

Sec. II. This ordinance shall become effective January 4, 1972.
