Section 1. That the Table of Organization of the Public Works Department is hereby amended to add the following:




BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte,

ORDINANCE NO. 785-X

AN ORDINANCE ORDERING THE DEMOLITION AND REMOVAL OF THE BUILDING AT 3401 - 11 NORTH DAVIDSON STREET PURSUANT TO THE BUILDING CODE OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE AND SECTION 6.61, ARTICLE IV, CHAPTER 6, CHARTER OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE.

WHEREAS, the building located at 3401-11 NORTH DAVIDSON STREET in the City of Charlotte has been found by the Superintendent of Building Inspection to be unsafe and dangerous to life by reason of structural damage - open to vagrants and the owners thereof, have been ordered to demolish building and remove the remnants of the building, all pursuant to the Building Code of the City of Charlotte and Section 6.61, Article IV, of the Charter of the City of Charlotte, and

WHEREAS, said owners have failed to comply with said order served by certified mail on February 5, 1973 and February 27, 1973,

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, that the Superintendent of Building Inspection is hereby ordered to cause the demolition and removal of the building located at 3401-11 N. Davidson Street in the City of Charlotte in accordance with the Building Code of the City of Charlotte and Section 6.61, Article IV, Chapter 6, of the Charter of the City of Charlotte.
