

ORDINANCE NO. 217

AMENDING CHAPTER 13, ARTICLE I

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 13 OF THE CODE OF THE
CITY OF CHARLOTTE TO REGULATE THE ADMITTANCE OF
MINORS TO POOLROOMS AND BILLIARD PARLORS

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina:

Section 1. That Chapter 13, Article I, of the Code of the City of Charlotte is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

"Sec. 13-5. No owner, manager, or person in charge of any poolroom or billiard parlor shall admit any minor under eighteen (18) years of age unless said minor shall be accompanied by his or her parent or legal guardian or shall have the written consent of his or her parent or legal guardian."

Section 2. A copy of this ordinance shall be conspicuously posted in every poolroom and billiard parlor having or required to have a city license.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.

ORDINANCE NO. 218

AMENDING CHAPTER 11, ARTICLE II
SECTION 11-18(250)

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 11, ARTICLE II,
SECTION 11-18(250) OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF
CHARLOTTE RELATIVE TO POOLROOMS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North
Carolina:

Section 1. That Chapter 11, Article II, Section 11-18(250) of the Code
of the City of Charlotte, is hereby amended by striking out and repealing
the next-to-last paragraph thereof beginning with the word "Provided",
and the last paragraph thereof beginning with the words, "Provided further".

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.
