

ORDINANCE NO. 243-X

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 176-X, THE 1971-72 BUDGET ORDINANCE, AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE ALCOHOLIC SAFETY ACTION PROJECT, THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A BUDGET, AND THE EMPLOYMENT OF APPROPRIATE STAFF.
