WHEREAS, The City plans to install two new traffic signals along Mallard Creek Church Road at Old Mallard Creek Church Road and at NC 49 in Charlotte. The City also plans to revise two signals along Mallard Creek Church Road at US 29 and at Mary Alexander Road/Bonnie Cone Lane, and install fiber optic communications cable along Mallard Creek Church Road from US 29 to NC 49 and from US 29 to J.W. Clay Boulevard in Charlotte; and,

WHEREAS, The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will be reimbursing the City actual costs of the project, up to \$449,111; and,


WHEREAS, The format and cost sharing philosophy with NCDOT is consistent with past municipal agreements.



A RESOLUTION DEFINING A MUNICIPAL SERVICE DISTRICT  
FOR THE UNIVERSITY CITY AREA

WHEREAS, Article 23 of the Chapter 160A of the North Carolina General Statutes entitled "The Municipal Service District Act of 1973" authorizes cities within North Carolina to define one or more service districts for the purpose enumerated in the Act and pursuant to the procedure therein prescribes; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to G.S. 160A-536, urban area revitalization projects are one of the purposes for which a municipal service district may be established; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to G.S. 160A-536, properties located within urban area municipal service districts must satisfy at least one of three statutory guidelines, including location in or surrounding existing or redeveloping concentrations of retail, office, or significant employment-generating uses; location surrounding major institutional uses, such as a university or hospital; or location within 1,500 feet of major transportation and transit corridors, except for residential parcels which must be within 150 feet.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Charlotte deems it desirable to define a service district as hereafter described for the purpose of promotion, development, and advocacy of its University City urban area and providing services to the district to a greater extent than provided for the remainder of the city; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Charlotte has caused to be prepared a report containing a map with the boundaries of the proposed district, statement that the district meets the standards set forth in G.S. 160A-536, and plan for providing services in the district, and made the report available for public inspection as provided by G.S. 160A-537(b); and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Charlotte has held a public hearing with public notice and property owner notification given as provided by G.S. 160A-537(c); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, that a municipal service district is hereby defined and established as including those properties between the Highway 29/49 connector off Interstate 85 on the south, Interstate 85 on the west, Mallard Creek Church Road on the north, and the rear property line of parcels on the east side of Highway 49 on the east that are depicted on a map attached hereto as Exhibit A, also being those properties with tax parcels listed on Exhibit B which is attached hereto. City Council hereby finds that said defined area is in need of promotional services to a greater extent than the remainder of the city; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that residential parcels further than 150 feet from these transportation corridors are excluded unless there was an overriding justification to include such parcels using one of the other statutory guidelines; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the services and functions provided to this district in addition to and to a greater extent than provided to the remainder of the city are to be undertaken in order to stimulate and encourage development; that such services and functions are to promote capital investment for all types of development including, but limited to, residential, commercial, office, and industrial land uses; that such services and functions are to promote users for such development so promoted; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Charlotte shall provide or let contracts for these services and functions within one year of the effective date of this resolution as provided by G.S. 160A-540(a); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an additional ad valorem tax be levied upon property located within this district to pay for these services and functions; this specific tax rate is to be set each fiscal year at the same time the citywide tax rate is set for the entire city; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that other revenues whose use is not otherwise restricted by law may be allocated to this service district; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall be effective on July 1, 2003, which is the beginning of the City of Charlotte's 2003-2004 fiscal year.


