Whereas, the U. S. Department of Transportation, Urban Mass Transportation Administration has set a minimum goal for the Federal share of grant-related contracts; therefore, be it resolved by the City Council of Charlotte, NC that the Mayor is authorized to execute documents establishing the City's FY 1989 goal for the Federal share of transit-related contracts at 13% for Disadvantaged Business Enterprises.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE  
REFUND OF CERTAIN TAXES
