RESOLUTION DECLARING AN INTENT TO ABANDON AND
CLOSE PITCHER STREET LOCATED BETWEEN DUNBAR
STREET AND I-277 RIGHT-OF-WAY IN THE CITY OF
CHARLOTTE, MECKLENBURG COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA.

WHEREAS, Wachovia Bank and Trust Company, N.A., Successor Trustee of the "Clanton First Generation Trust" and the "Clanton Second Generation Trust", and Isabelle Clanton Kennamer, have filed a Petition to close Pitcher Street in the City of Charlotte; and

WHEREAS, Pitcher Street petitioned to be closed lies between Dunbar Street on the North and the State Department of Transportation right-of-way for Interstate I-277 (Project Number 8.1654826) on the South, as shown on a map marked "Exhibit A", and is more particularly described by metes and bounds in a document marked "Exhibit B", and designated on the tax maps of Mecklenburg County as indicated on a map marked "Exhibit C", all of which are available for inspection in the Office of the City Clerk, City Hall, Charlotte, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, the procedure for closing streets and alleys as outlined in North Carolina General Statutes, Section 160A-299, requires that Council first adopt a resolution declaring its intent to close the street and calling a public hearing on the question; and said Statute further requires that the resolution shall be published once a week for four successive weeks prior to the hearing, and a copy thereof be sent by registered or certified mail to all owners of property adjoining the street as shown on the county tax records, and a notice of the closing and public hearing shall be prominently posted in at least two places along said street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, at its regularly scheduled session of October 17, 1983, that it intends to close Pitcher Street lying between Dunbar Street and I-277 right-of-way, said street being more particularly described on a map and by a metes and bounds description available for inspection in the City Clerk's Office, and hereby calls a public hearing on the question to be held at 3:00 p.m., on Monday, the 14th day of November, 1983, at City Hall.
The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish a copy of this resolution in The Mecklenburg Times once a week for four successive weeks next preceding the date fixed here for such hearing, as required by N.C.G.S. 160A-299.
