TRADEMART RESOLUTION

WHEREAS Charlotte has for many years been the host for growing and dynamic TRADEMARKET facilities serving the Carolinas and Virginia, and

WHEREAS the TRADEMARKET facilities have been a major contributing element in the growth of Charlotte, providing jobs and increased activity, and

WHEREAS the City supports the Charlotte Convention and Visitors Bureau and County efforts to aggressively promote the City as a trademarket center,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the City desires to engage in negotiations concerning: 1) the development of a permanent home for the trade shows in Charlotte under a financial structure similar to that presently being considered (including a review of proposed developer cost estimates, a determination of the potential impact of pending federal legislation and the identification of sources of funding to bridge any financial commitment by the City); and 2) the feasibility of transportation, advertising and other non-construction inducements at issue;

AND FURTHER, that the City requests that the CVFE delay their location decision for 60 days, during which these negotiations can properly occur.
