In June and July of 2019, Charlotte City Council awarded construction contracts for five projects in the West Trade/Rozzelles Ferry Comprehensive Neighborhood Improvement Program area. These projects are designed to encourage walking and cycling, promote redevelopment, enhance resident safety and provide public space for the community to use and enjoy. United of Carolinas Inc. and Sealand Contractors Corporation are expected to start construction this fall. During this time, City inspectors will visit the construction sites daily. We will make every effort to minimize disruption and inconvenience during construction, and we appreciate your patience.

Five Points Plaza



This project is located at the intersection where West Trade Street, State Street, 5th Street and Beatties Ford Road convene. Five Points Plaza will be a vibrant community gathering space that will include landscaping, pedestrian lighting, artwork and signage, an amphitheater, water splash pad, swings, tables and chairs, solar-lit brick pavers, sidewalk and a decorative wall. There will also be an area designated for food trucks.

I-77/West Trade Street Underpass



The underpass at I-77 along West Trade Street is an important connection between uptown and the Historic West End. Enhancements to this underpass include wide sidewalks, curb and gutter, wheelchair ramps, signage and artwork, lighting, benches, landscaping and a decorative retaining wall. When complete, the underpass will provide a safe, comfortable connection for pedestrians, cyclists and motorists traveling between uptown and the West End.

State Street Pedestrian Improvement

This project will transform State Street into a pedestrian-friendly street that will connect major trip generators at each end of the corridor, as well as Johnson C. Smith University and Old Savona Mills. Construction will include new sidewalk on one side of the street, curb and gutter, street resurfacing, drainage improvements, traffic-calming features, planting strips with trees and high-visibility crosswalks at key intersections along State Street.

Rozzelles Ferry Pedscape



This project is located between Zebulon Avenue and the Five Points intersection. When complete, it will connect students, commuters and residents with safe access to Johnson C. Smith University, the CityLYNX Gold Line, the Stewart Creek Greenway and Martin Luther King Park. Construction will include pedestrian refuge medians, wheelchair ramps, street resurfacing, drainage improvements, landscaping and street trees.

Yellowstone Drive/Zebulon Avenue Street Connectivity



This project will extend from the intersection of Zebulon Avenue and Rozzelles Ferry Road to the intersection of Yellowstone Drive and Coronet Way. Once complete, the project will improve access and visibility for Martin Luther King Park and Stewart Creek Greenway and encourage private development along Rozzelles Ferry Road and the business park on Zebulon Avenue. Construction will include a new bridge and roadway, street resurfacing, wide multiuse sidewalks and pedestrian lighting.
