- This project is in the planning phase. The phases of the project were explained (Planning, Design, Real Estate, Bid, Construction).
- The engineering consultant for this project is Armstrong Glen, PC (AG).

- AG reviewed the results of their stormwater modeling using maps.
- A question/answer session was held.
- Three break-out groups were created to answer specific questions.
