CMPD Update & Progress: Wilmore Parking Concerns

- June 2023, CMPD Central assigned two officer and Sgt. Ramsey to target noise and parking violations working 4th shift 7 days a week with a focus on South End.
- Central Division has issued 81 parking citations in the Wilmore Neighborhood YTD and Park-It has issued 54 citations for a total of 135 citations. Park-It agents currently don't work past 10 p.m.
- CMPD Central ordered a TC26 handheld citation machine in July through Park-It which will be operational in weeks and be utilized by our 4th shift officers for parking violations.
- CMPD Analyst Madison Wellen ran citizen calls for service for Wilmore YTD which showed 530 total calls and 22 or 4% of those were for illegal parking.
- CDOT has held two separate meetings on parking for Wilmore with only a few residents in attendance and the South End Strategic Parking Plan meeting is planned on August 31st, 2023. CMPD has attended all the meetings and Mr. Hawkins was asked to please have residents attend.
- CMPD Central CRU Unit works 4th shift on weekends and specifically targets unlawful behavior around the nightclubs to include South End.
- CMPD Central agrees that the low fine amount of \$25 does not deter subjects from illegally parking. CDOT Park-IT advised they have requested an increase through council but were denied with a response that we want to be a parking friendly city.
- CMPD Central will begin towing of illegally parked vehicles within policy immediately to curb the community's concerns regarding unlawful parking.
