Community Resilience Fund Grants Totaling \$2.5M Awarded to Area Non-Profits

The City of Charlotte has awarded operating support grants totaling \$2.5M to 93 area non-profit organizations through the Community Resilience Fund (CRF). The CRF is an American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) State & Local Fiscal Recovery Fund supported grant opportunity, prioritizing work that fosters racial equity and economic mobility in marginalized communities.

Applications were open to eligible nonprofit organizations serving communities that have been disparately impacted by COVID-19. Overall, 202 applications were received exceeding \$28.5M in requests.

An additional \$1M in CRF funds have been allocated to administrative partner Hispanic Federation, with further grant awards expected in October 2023. In total, the CRF expects to award up to \$3.5M, comprising +/-\$1M for small grassroots nonprofit organizations, and +/-\$2.5 million for medium and large nonprofit organizations.
