A joint meeting of the City Council and the Board of County Commissioners was held in the Mayor's Office, City Hall, at 3:30 o'clock p.m., Wednesday, November 3, 1937, with Mayor Ben E. Douglas presiding.

Mayor Douglas called on Mr. Harkey, Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, to state the purpose of the joint meeting. Mr. Harkey stated that it was necessary, a required by law, to elect a Tax Supervisor for Mecklenburg County for a two-year term from the first Monday in December 1937. (See Chapter 265 Public-Local Laws 1931).

ELECTION OF TAX SUPERVISOR.

Councilman Albea nominated Mr. J. Arthur Henderson and moved that he be elected for a term of two years. Nomination and motion seconded by Commissioner Wearn.

Councilman Durham moved that the nominations be closed. This motion seconded by Commissioner Wearn and carried unanimously.

A vote was then taken on Councilman Albea's motion, which had been seconded by Commissioner Wearn. The vote for Mr. Henderson was unanimous and the chair deklared him elected.

SALARY OF HATTIE RUBBELL INCREASED \$10.00 PER MONTH.

Councilman Sides stated that the salary of Hattie Russell, colored case worker of the Domestic Relations Court, had not been raised along with the others, and moved that she be granted a raise of \$10.00 per month and that same be made retroactive to July 1, 1937. This motion seconded by Commissioner Wearn and unanimously carried.

ADJOURNMENT.

On motion of Councilman Wilkinson, seconded by Commissioner Price, and carried, the meeting adjourned.
