The City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, met in an adjourned meeting on Thursday, April 12, 1973, at 11:00 o'clock a.m., in the County Commissioners Board Room, County Office Building, with Mayor John M. Belk presiding, and Councilmembers Fred D. Alexander, Ruth M. Easterling, Sandy R. Jordan, James D. McDuffie, Milton Short, James B. Whittington, and Joe D. Withrow present.

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER.

Mayor Belk called the meeting to order for the purpose of receiving from the registrars and judges of election in the various precincts of the City of Charlotte the returns of the special bond election held on April 10, 1973.

RESOLUTION CANVASSING THE RETURNS OF THE SPECIAL BOND ELECTION HELD APRIL 10, 1973, AND DETERMINING AND DECLARING THE RESULT THEREOF.
