

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING January 16, 1961, ON
A PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE. (1323 THE PLAZA).

WHEREAS, at the meeting of the City Council on December 12, 1960, the
following amendment to the City Code was introduced:

"Ordinance No. 714. An Ordinance Amending Chapter 21 of the City Code -
Zoning Ordinance

An Ordinance Amending the City Code with Respect to the Zoning Ordinance

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 21, Article I, Section 2 of the City Code of the City
of Charlotte, (O. B. 10) be amended by having Building Zone Map of the City of
Charlotte amended by changing from Residence 2 to Business 1 the following de-
scribed property:

BEGINNING at a point in the westerly margin of The Plaza, said point
being the common front corner of Lots 13 and 14 in Block 25 as shown
on a map of Chatham Land Company, Oakhurst Lots, recorded in Map Book
230, page 244 in the office of the Register of Deeds for Mecklenburg
County, North Carolina, and running thence with the line between said
Lots 13 and 14 151.5 feet to the easterly margin of a 12 foot alley-
way; thence with said margin in a southerly direction 65 feet, more
or less, to an existing Business 1 Zoning District boundary line;
thence with said boundary line in an easterly direction 155 feet,
more or less, to a point in the westerly margin of The Plaza; thence
with said margin in a northerly direction 40 feet, more or less, to
the BEGINNING, and being that portion of Lots 12 and 13 in Block 25
as shown on the aforementioned map not presently zoned for Business 1
purposes.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption after
a public hearing in connection therewith."

AND, WHEREAS, under the law no amendment to the zoning ordinance can be adopted
until a public hearing thereon is held, of which public hearing notice is re-
quired to be given publication not less than fifteen days immediately preceding
the date of such hearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE:

1. That January 16, 1961, at 2 o'clock p.m. be fixed
as the time and the Council Chamber in the City Hall as the place for the pub-
lic hearing on the proposed amendment as above set out.

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING January 16, 1961,

(East side Statesville Avenue, North of Kohler Avenue)

WHEREAS, at the meeting of the City Council on December 12, 1960,
the following amendment to the City Code was introduced:

"Ordinance No. 715. An Ordinance Amending Chapter 21 of the City
Code - Zoning Ordinance

An Ordinance Amending the City Code with Respect to the Zoning Ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE:

Section 1. That Chapter 21, Article I, Section 2 of the City Code
of the City of Charlotte (O. B. 10) be amended by having Building
Zone Map of the City of Charlotte amended by changing from Residence
2 to Business 1 the following described property:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the easterly margin of Statesville
Avenue and the northerly margin of Kohler Avenue and running thence
with said margin of Statesville Avenue N. 2-56-20 W. 475.43 feet
to an iron; thence N. 87-56-10 E. 414.31 feet to an iron; thence S.
34-56 W. 503.46 feet to an iron; thence S. 56-28-10 E. 113.54 feet
to an iron in the northerly margin of Kohler Avenue; thence with
said margin S. 85-50-20 W. 196.54 feet to the BEGINNING and being a
2.643 acre tract of land belonging to Domar Corporation, Inc.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective upon its
adoption after a public hearing in connection therewith."

AND, WHEREAS, under the law no amendment to the zoning ordinance can be adopted
until a public hearing thereon is held, of which public hearing notice is re-
quired to be given publication not less than fifteen days immediately preceding
the date of such hearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE:

time and the Council Chamber in the City Hall as the place for the public hear-
