RESOLUTION ADOPTING SETBACK LINES ON EAST AND WEST FOURTH STREET FROM THE SOUTHERN RAILROAD UNDERPASS TO MINT STREET.

That setback lines are hereby established and approved in accordance with the map prepared by the City Engineering Department dated May 9, 1960 entitled: "East and West Fourth Street Widening Lines, from the Southern Railroad Underpass to Mint Street", which map was prepared in accordance with the Resolution of the City Council under date of March 28, 1956 and recorded in Resolutions Book 2, at Page 404, setting forth the established procedure for the creation of setback lines in the City of Charlotte
