

RESOLUTION REQUESTING MEMORIAL HOSPITAL BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO REPORT CONCERNING THEIR ACTION RELATIVE TO GOOD SAMARITAN HOSPITAL AS REQUESTED BY COUNCIL ON AUGUST 1, 1960.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Charlotte on August 1, 1960, requested the Board of Trustees of Memorial Hospital, among other things, "to proceed with the preliminary steps attendant to said Board, assuming full jurisdiction over the operation of Good Samaritan Hospital", and also, "to proceed with the detailed planning phase of renovations to be made to Good Samaritan Hospital with bond money", approved by the citizens of Charlotte;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, that the Board of Trustees of Memorial Hospital are requested to report to this City Council concerning the requested action above referred to of August 1, 1960.
