> ORDINANCE NO. 18 AMENDING CHAPTER 20 TRAFFIC, WITH RESPECT TO STANDING FOR Loading ONLY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE:

Section 1. That, Chapter 20 of the City Code of the City of Charlotte be, and the same is, hereby amended by inserting under Article IV a new Section 20-73 entitled: "Standing for Loading Only".

-(a)--No-person-shall-stop,-stand;-or-park-a-vehicle-for---any-purpose-or-period-of-time-other-than-for-the-ex---peditious-loading-or-unloading-of-passengers-in-any--place-marked-as-a-passenger-zone-during-the-hours-when---only-for-a-period-not-to-exceed-3-minutes.---

(a) (b)- No person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle for any purpose or length of time other than for the expeditious unloading and delivery or pick-up and loading of materials within the block and any place marked as a loading zone during the hours when the provisions applicable to loading zones are in effect. In no case shall the stop for loading and unloading of materials exceed 15 minutes.
