ORDINANCE NO. 35

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 20, ARTICLE I, SECTION 20-21 OF THE CITY CODE WITH RESPECT TO WRECKER AND STORAGE CHARGES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE:

Section 1. That, Chapter 20, Article I, Section 20-21 of the City

Code of the City of Charlotte be, and the same is herby amended by

striking out sub-sections (a) and (b) and substituting in lieu

thereof, the following:

- (a) "A charge of ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be made for the use of the wrecker, provided such vehicle is towed to the municipal lot, or to the zone wrecker lot or garage; however, if the owner of such vehicle appears before his vehicle is towed away and makes claim to his vehicle, after the wrecker has been ordered to remove such vehicle, the charge shall be two dollars (\$2.00).
- (b) Storage charges on stored or impounded vehicles shall be one dollar (\$1.00) per day for each of the first seven days if retained over five hours, and fifty cents (50ϕ) per day for each day or portion of a day thereafter."

Section 2. That, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption.
