

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR A PUBLIC
HEARING SEPTEMBER 18, 1961, ON A
PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING
ORDINANCE.

(North side Shamrock Drive between
Eastway Drive and Finchby Drive)

WHEREAS, at the meeting of the City Council on August 14, 1961,
the following amendment to the City Code was introduced:

"Ordinance No. 42-Z. An Ordinance Amending Chapter 23 of
the City Code - Zoning Ordinance

An Ordinance Amending the City Code with
Respect to the Zoning Ordinance

'BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE:

Section 1. That Chapter 23, Article II, Section 23-43 of the City
Code of the City of Charlotte, be amended by having Building Zone
Map of the Charlotte Perimeter Area amended by changing from
Residence 2 to Business 1 the following described property:

Being all of Lots 6-11 in Block E as shown on a map
of McDonald Heights recorded in Map Book 3, Page 280
in the Office of the Register of Deeds for Mecklenburg
County, North Carolina.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective upon its
adoption after a public hearing in connection therewith.'

AND, WHEREAS, under the law no amendment to the Zoning Ordinance
can be adopted until a public hearing thereon is held, of which
public hearing notice is required to be given publication not
less than fifteen days immediately preceding the date of such
hearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CHARLOTTE:

1. That September 18, 1961, at 2 o'clock p.m., be fixed as the
time and the Council Chamber in the City Hall as the place for the
public hearing on the proposed amendment as above set out.
