A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE PAY PLAN OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, that the Pay Plan heretofore adopted by the City Council on September 18, 1961, as amended on November 20, 1961, is hereby further amended as follows:

(1) A new Schedule I, "Pay Ranges in Bi-Weekly Amounts," attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby adopted in lieu of and shall superseded the present Schedule I, for the purposes of extending the number of pay ranges from 37 to 42 and to include equivalent annual rates for Steps A and F of each pay range.

(2) In Schedule III, "Pay Range Assignment of Classes," the following pay ranges are hereby assigned in lieu of and shall superseded the present pay ranges for the following classes respectively:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that salaries of personnel in each of the classes set forth in this resolution shall, as of April 1, 1962, be set at the lowest pay step above Step A in their respective pay ranges as will provide an increase in their respective present salaries; provided, that in effecting the initial installation of the foregoing pay ranges, the City Manager may designate such other pay step, within the respective pay ranges assigned, for any of the foregoing personnel as he deems essential to the proper discharge of his administrative responsibility. Thereafter, salary increments for the foregoing classes shall be governed by the pay plan applicable to all classes of personnel.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that May 14, 1962 is hereby established as the anniversary date for determination of subsequent salary increments for the classes set forth in this resolution.
