AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE CORPORATE LIMITS
OF THE CTTY OF CHAPLOTTE, NORTH CAROLINA.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, has been petitioned under G.S. 160-452, as amended, to annex the area described herein, and

WERREAS, the City Clerk has certified the sufficiency of said petition and a public hearing on the question of this annexation was held in the Council Chamber, in the City Hall, at 3 oblock pom. on the 23 rd day of September, 1963, and

THEREAS, the City Council does hereby find as a fact that said petition meets the recuirements of $G$. $S_{.} 160-452$, as amended.

NOF, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDATNED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina:

Section 1. By virtue of the authority granted by G. S. 160-452, as amended, the following described territory is hereby annexed and made part of the City of Charlotte, as the 7th day of October, 1963:

Section 4. This ordinance shall be published once, following the effective date of annexation, in a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Charlotte.
