ORDINANCE NO. 199-X

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING STREET NAMES AND NAMING NEW SECTIONS OF STREETS

WHEREAS, the construction of the Kenilworth Avenue Extension project has necessitated changing the name of Fernwood Drive and a portion of Baxter Street and naming new sections of streets in order to maintain continuity of street names,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina:

Section 1. That Fernwood Drive, from Ordermore Avenue to Ideal Way, and the new sections of street from East Boulevard to Ideal Way and from Ordermore Avenue to Kenilworth Avenue, all are hereby named Scott Avenue. Section 2. That the new sections of street extending Kenilworth Avenue from Ordermore Avenue to Park Road and from Greenwood Cliff to Baxter Street, are hereby named Kenilworth Avenue; and further, that portion of Baxter Street, from its intersection with Kenilworth Avenue to Independence Boulevard, is hereby renamed Kenilworth Avenue.

Section 3. That these street names shall become effective upon the erection of appropriate street name signs.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.
