

ORDINANCE NO. 233

AMENDING CHAPTER 20, ARTICLE I,
SECTION 20-15.1 (g) (3)

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 20-15.1 (g)(3), ARTICLE I, CHAPTER 20
OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE RELATIVE TO PUBLIC HEARINGS ON
OBSTRUCTIONS TO CROSS-VISIBILITY AT INTERSECTIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte,
North Carolina:

Section 1. Section 20-15.1 (g) (3), Article I, Chapter 20 of the
Code of the City of Charlotte is hereby amended by inserting the
following sentence between the first and second sentences thereof;

"If any person receiving such notice and order does not
comply with the order and does not request in writing
a hearing before the City Council within said ten (10)
day period, the traffic engineer shall request in writing
that the City Council fix the date of hearing and shall
notify the person upon whom the notice and order has been
served of the time and place of such hearing."

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.
