

STATEMENT OF RESULT OF
THE SPECIAL BOND ELECTION
held in the
CITY OF CHARLOTTE, NORTH CAROLINA
on January 23, 1965

At a special bond election held on January 23, 1965

87,959 voters were registered and qualified to vote.

At said election 7,345 votes were cast for the ordinance authorizing the City of Charlotte to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$6,615,000 Water Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for enlarging and extending the waterworks system of said City, including the acquisition, construction and enlargement of water supply, storage, treatment and distribution facilities and the acquisition of necessary land and rights of way, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 2,005 votes were cast against said ordinance, and a majority of the qualified voters of said City who voted thereon at said election having voted in favor of the approval of said ordinance, said ordinance was thereby approved and is in force and effect.

At said election 7,340 votes were cast for the ordinance authorizing the City of Charlotte to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$1,985,000 Sanitary Sewer Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for enlarging and extending the sanitary sewer system of said City, including the acquisition, construction and enlargement of sewage collection, treatment and disposal facilities and the acquisition of necessary land and rights of way, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 1,991

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We certify that the following is a true and correct copy of the ordinance as passed by the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, on the _____ day of _____, 1965.

At a meeting of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, held on said date, the following ordinance was passed and approved by a majority of the qualified voters of said City who voted thereon at said election having voted in favor of the approval of said ordinance, said ordinance was thereby approved and is in force and effect.

At said election 4,804 votes were cast for the ordinance authorizing the City of Charlotte to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$6,410,000 Street and Bonding Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for acquiring land for streets and highways within the City of Charlotte, including streets and highways forming a part of the State Highway System, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 2,442 votes were cast against said ordinance, and a majority of the qualified voters of said City who voted thereon at said election having voted in favor of the approval of said ordinance, said ordinance was thereby approved and is in force and effect.

At said election 5,001 votes were cast for the ordinance authorizing the City of Charlotte to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$3,500,000 Street Widening, Extension and Improvement Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for widening, extending and constructing or reconstructing the surface of principal thoroughfares in said City, including the contemporaneous construction or reconstruction of sidewalks, curbs, gutters, drains and grading, and the acquisition of necessary land and rights of way, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 2,421 votes were cast against said ordinance, and a majority of the quali-

fied voters of said City who voted thereon at said election having voted in favor of the approval of said ordinance, said ordinance was thereby approved and is in force and effect.

At said election 6,889 votes were cast for the ordinance authorizing the City of Charlotte to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$470,000 Street Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for widening, extending and constructing or reconstructing the surface of streets in said City, including the contemporaneous construction or reconstruction of sidewalks, curbs, gutters, drains and grading, and the acquisition of necessary land and rights of way, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 2,383 votes were cast against said ordinance, and a majority of the qualified voters of said City who voted thereon at said election having voted in favor of the approval of said ordinance, said ordinance was thereby approved and is in force and effect.

At said election 6,690 votes were cast for the ordinance authorizing the City of Charlotte to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$2,000,000 Police Headquarters Building Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for erecting and equipping a building for use as a headquarters building for the police department, including the acquisition of necessary land, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 2,577 votes were cast against said ordinance, and a majority of the qualified voters of said City who voted thereon at said election having voted in favor of the approval of said ordinance, said ordinance was there-

By approved and is in force and effect.

At said election _____ 3. _____ votes were cast for the ordinance authorizing the City of Charlotte to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue and encumbering \$120,000 Fire Station Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for erecting and equipping a building for use as a fire station for the fire department, including the acquisition of any necessary land, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and _____ 2,114 _____ votes were cast against said ordinance, and a majority of the qualified voters of said City who voted thereon at said election having voted in favor of the approval of said ordinance, said ordinance was thereby approved and is in force and effect.
