

RESOLUTION FIXING A DATE OF PUBLIC
HEARING ON THE CLOSING OF A PORTION
OF BRUNSWICK AVENUE.

WHEREAS, Brunswick Avenue, east of Kings Drive, has been realigned so that the Eastern intersection with Kings Drive is now located directly opposite the Western intersection of Kings Drive and Brunswick Avenue; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the original Brunswick Avenue, lying between Kings Drive and the new realigned Brunswick Avenue is no longer in use and the right of way is no longer needed for street purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City of Charlotte desires to close and abandon that portion of Brunswick Avenue no longer needed for street purposes; and

WHEREAS, the procedure for closing streets as outlined in North Carolina General Statutes, Section 160-220 (11) and Section 153-9 (17), requires a public hearing after notice to the abutting land owners not joining in the petition and after publication in a newspaper once a week for four consecutive weeks;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte that a public hearing on the question of closing that portion of the original Brunswick Avenue lying between Kings Drive and the new realigned Brunswick Avenue shall be held at 3 p.m. on Monday, the 19th day of July, 1965, in the Council Chamber of the City Hall. The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish such a notice in The Charlotte News once a week for four consecutive weeks next preceding the date fixed for such hearing, as required by G.S. 153-9 (17).
