

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CONDEMNATION PROCEEDINGS FOR ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY OF G. E. VINROOT CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, LOCATED AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SHARON-AMITY AND MONROE ROADS FOR SHARON-AMITY WIDENING PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds as a fact that it is necessary to acquire certain property of G. E. Vinroot Construction Company, located at the Northeast corner of Sharon-Amity and Monroe Roads, for right of way purposes for the Sharon-Amity Widening Project; and

WHEREAS, the City has in good faith undertaken to negotiate for the purchase of this property but has been unable to reach an agreement with the owner for the purchase price;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte that, pursuant to Section 7.81, Chapter 713 of the 1965 Session Laws of North Carolina, condemnation proceedings are hereby authorized to be instituted against the property of G. E. Vinroot Construction Company, located at the Northeast corner of Sharon-Amity and Monroe Roads in the City of Charlotte under the procedures set forth in Article 2, Chapter 40, of the General Statutes of North Carolina, as amended.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT WITH THE STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION PROVIDING FOR TRAFFIC OPERATING CONTROLS FOR PROJECT W.O. 9.7100307

WHEREAS, the North Carolina State Highway Commission and the City of Charlotte entered into an agreement dated the 24th day of W.O. 9.7100307, Mecklenburg County; and

WHEREAS, the City is empowered by the General Statutes of North Carolina, Section 160-200(31) and Section 136-18(5), to provide adequate traffic operating controls for the safe and efficient utilization of the highways, and it is proper that the City cooperate with said Commission to the extent of establishing and maintaining traffic operating controls for the regulation and movement of traffic on said project,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CHARLOTTE;

That the supplemental Municipal Agreement proposed to provide adequate operating controls for the safe and efficient utilization of the highway under Project W.O. 9.7100307, Mecklenburg County, is hereby formally approved by the City Council of the City of Charlotte and that the Mayor or City Clerk (or Manager) of this Municipality be and they are hereby empowered to sign and execute the contract.
