WHEREAS, the building located at 1107 East Fourth Street in the City of Charlotte has been found by the Superintendent of Building Inspection to be unsafe and dangerous to life by reason of the partial destruction by fire, and the owners thereof have been ordered to demolish and remove the remnants^{of}/the building, all pursuant to the Building Code of the City of Charlotte, Section 6.61, Article IV, Chapter 6, of the Charter of the City of Charlotte, and

WHEREAS, said owners have failed to comply with said order served by registered mail on the June 5, 1967 and July 19, 1967,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, that the Superintendent of Building Inspection is hereby ordered to cause the demolition and removal of the building located at 1107 East Fourth Street in the City of Charlotte in accordance with the Building Code of the City of Charlotte, and Section 6161, Article IV, Chapter 6, of the Charter of the City of Charlotte.
