

RESOLUTION FIXING DATE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PETITION FOR LOCAL IMPROVEMENTS OF DRUID CIRCLE, FROM MORETZ AVENUE TO STATESVILLE AVENUE.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed 61% of the abutting property owners, representing 62% of the lineal feet of frontage, requesting that Druid Circle, from Moretz Avenue to Statesville Avenue, be permanently improved by the construction of roll type curbing and gutters and the installation of storm drainage facilities, and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City Council to hold public hearings on petitions for local improvements prior to ordering the making of such improvements, NOW, THEREFORE,

Section 1: Introduction

The following table shows the results of the experiment. The data is presented in a clear and concise manner, allowing for easy comparison of the different conditions. The results are as follows:

Condition	Result 1	Result 2	Result 3
Condition A	1.2	2.5	3.8
Condition B	1.5	2.8	4.1
Condition C	1.8	3.1	4.4
Condition D	2.1	3.4	4.7
Condition E	2.4	3.7	5.0

The data indicates that as the condition number increases, the results also increase. This suggests a positive correlation between the two variables. The results are consistent across all conditions, with no significant outliers.
