on "Exhibit A" hereto attached and made a part herof.

Section 3. Legal notice of said public hearing shall be published in
The Charlotte News, a newspaper having general circulation in the City of
Charlotte, at least ten (10) days prior to the date of said public
hearing.

EXHIBIT A

SITUATE, lying and being in Sharon Township, Mecklenburg County, North Carolina, and being more particularly described and defined as follows:

BEGINNING at the point of intersection between the southeasterly margin of Rama Road and the center line of the Seaboard Railroad right-of-way, and runs thence with said margin of Rama Road North 43-35-30 East 1,314.06 feet to an iron in said margin; thence with three lines of Mrs. Jessie Hunter (now or formerly) as follows: (1) South 71-06-30 East 149.26 feet to an iron, (2) South 3-35-50 West 748.42 feet to an iron; and (3) North 63-26-30 East 470.39 feet to an iron; thence with a line of the Wallace property (now or formerly) South 10-40-18 East 965.04 feet to an iron; thence with a line of the property of the Margaret W. McLaughlin heirs South 15-56-30 East 513.10 feet to an iron; thence South 61-45-10 West 226.76 feet to an iron; thence in a southeasterly direction with the arc of a circular curve to the right, the radius of which is 2,199.86 feet, a distance of 49.26 feet to an iron; thence South 63-02-10 West 290.0 feet to a point in the center line of the Seaboard Railroad right-of-way; thence with the center line of said right-of-way in a northwesterly direction in two courses and distances as follows: (1) with the arc of a circular curve to the left, the radius of which is 1,909.86 feet, a distance of 688.05 feet to a point, and (2) North 47-35-20 West 1,205.81 feet to the point and place of BEGINNING, and containing 42.2705 acres all as shown on "Plat of Property to be Annexed to City of Charlotte" made by Keith R. Moen, Registered Surveyor, dated September 24, 1968.

ANNEX A

ANNEX A, lying and being in Sharon Township, Madison County, North Carolina, and being more particularly described and defined as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection between the southeasterly margin of Main Road and the center line of the Railroad right-of-way, and from thence with said margin of Main Road North 47-32-30 East 1,312.00 feet to an iron in said margin; thence with chain line of Main Road (now or formerly) as follows: (1) South 71-00-30 East 148.75 feet to an iron; (2) South 1-32-30 West 744.44 feet to an iron; and (3) North 82-32-30 East 470.12 feet to an iron; thence with a line of the Wallace property (now or formerly) South 10-40-10 East 322.04 feet to an iron; thence with a line of the property of the University of North Carolina South 12-32-30 East 211.10 feet to an iron; thence South 61-42-10 West 228.78 feet to an iron; thence in a southeasterly direction with the arc of a circular curve to the right, the radius of which is 1,192.55 feet, a distance of 48.22 feet to an iron; thence South 67-02-10 West 157.0 feet to a point in the center line of the Railroad Railroad right-of-way; thence with the center line of said right-of-way in a southeasterly direction in two courses and distances as follows: (1) with the arc of a circular curve to the left, the radius of which is 1,002.55 feet, a distance of 554.05 feet to a point; and (2) North 47-32-30 East 1,302.01 feet to the point and place of BEGINNING, and containing 42,370.2 acres all as shown on "Plan of Property to be Acquired in City of Charlotte" made by Keith A. Moon, Registered Surveyor, dated September 14, 1968.
