RESOLUTION GRANTING POWER OF ATTORNEY TO THE CHIEF OF POLICE FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF EXECUTING FORMS REQUIRED BY FEDERAL LAWS RELATING TO THE USE OF SPIRITS FREE OF TAX.
