

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CONDEMNATION PROCEEDINGS FOR ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY OF BENJAMIN DONALD HARRY AND WIFE, HANSEL GUEST HARRY, LOCATED AT 4116 NORTH TRYON STREET FOR SUGAR CREEK ROAD - NORTH TRYON STREET INTERSECTION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds as a fact that it is necessary to acquire certain property of Benjamin Donald Harry and wife, Hansel Guest Harry, located at 4116 North Tryon Street in the City of Charlotte for right of way purposes for the Sugar Creek Road - North Tryon Street Intersection Project; and

WHEREAS, the City has in good faith undertaken to negotiate for the purchase of this property but has been unable to reach an agreement with the owners for the purchase price;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$2,500,00, the amount of the appraised value of said property, is hereby authorized to be deposited in the office of the Clerk of Superior Court of Mecklenburg County, North Carolina, together with the filing of the Complaint and Declaration of Taking.
