WHEREAS, the City of Charlotte entered into an agreement with the Redevelopment Commission of the City of Charlotte, dated September 16, 1964, amended November 1, 1966, and March 13, 1967, with respect to the Redevelopment Area Plan for Redevelopment Section No. 3, Brooklyn Urban Renewal Area, and

WHEREAS, Section 4 of that agreement provides that the City will, at no cost or expense to the Commission, and upon the Commission's request, vacate the streets, roads, alleys and other public ways to be eliminated in preparing the Project Area for its new uses, as shown in the Redevelopment Area Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Commission has requested the City, in accordance with Section 4 of said Agreement, to vacate and close up the said portions of Crockett Street, Plum Street, South Long Street, East First Street, Bell Alley and East Second Street, in the City of Charlotte, Mecklenburg County, North Carolina, as shown on Wilbur Smith and Associates Map of Brooklyn Urban Renewal Area, Redevelopment Section No. 3, N. C. R-37, Abandonment of Existing Street Right of Way, dated July 31, 1969, said portions of said streets being more particularly described as follows:

C. R-37, Abandonment of Existing Street Right of Way, dated July 31, 1969, said portions of said streets being more particularly described hereinabove, shall be held at __3__P. M., on Monday, the _lst_day of __December _____, 1969, in the Council Chamber of the City Hall. The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish such a notice in the "Charlotte News" once a week for four consecutive weeks next preceding the date fixed here for such hearing, as required by G. S. 153-9 (17).


