AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO PROVIDE FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF CLEMSON AVENUE AND MATOON STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1. That the sum of \$11,700 is transferred from Account 4110 in the Powell Bill Fund to Account 4110 in the General Fund.

Section 2. That the sum of \$11,700 be appropriated from the General Fund Account 4110 to Account 513.04 (Minor Street Improvement), these funds to be used for the purpose of improving Clemson Avenue at Highland Elementary School (\$7,000) and for the improvement of Matoon Street (\$4,700).

Section 3. That this ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.
