RESOLUTION

Be it resolved by the City Council _____ of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, _____ in regular meeting assembled that the Mayor of said City _____ be, and he hereby is, authorized to enter into an agreement with the SEABOARD COAST LINE RAILROAD COMPANY, and to sign same on behalf of said City whereby said Railroad Company grants unto said City the right or license to install and maintain, for the purpose of a sewer main, a line of pipe across the right of way and underneath said lead track of said Railroad Company at Charlotte, North Carolina; as more particularly described in said agreement, which agreement is dated October 5, 1972, a copy of which agreement is filed with this City Council.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CONDEMNATION PROCEEDINGS FOR THE ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY BELONGING TO ROBERT G. SPRATT, JR. AND WIFE, JEAN SPRATT, LOCATED ON WILMONT ROAD AT BYRUM DRIVE IN BERRYHILL TOWNSHIP IN CONNECTION WITH THE AIRPORT EXPANSION PROJECT.


WHEREAS, the City Council finds as a fact that it is necessary to acquire certain property belonging to Robert G. Spratt, Jr. and wife, Jean Spratt, located on Wilmont Road at Byrum Drive in Berryhill Township for light lane in middle marker location in connection with the Airport Expansion Project; and

WHEREAS, the City has in good faith undertaken to negotiate for the purchase of this property, but has been unable to reach an agreement with the owners for the purchase price.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, that pursuant to Section 7.81, Chapter 713 of the 1965 Session Laws of North Carolina, being the Charter of the City of Charlotte as amended by Chapter 216, 1967 Session Laws of North Carolina, and further amended by Chapter 384, 1969 Session Laws of North Carolina, condemnation proceedings are hereby authorized to be instituted against the property of Robert G. Spratt, Jr. and wife, Jean Spratt, located on Wilmont Road at Byrum Drive in Berryhill Township, Mecklenburg County, under the procedures sets forth in Article 9, Chapter 136 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, as amended; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$12,000.00, the amount of the appraised value of said property, is hereby authorized to be deposited in the office of the Clerk of the Superior Court of Mecklenburg County, North Carolina, together with the filing of the Complaint and Declaration of Taking.
