A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CONDEMNATION PROCEEDINGS FOR THE ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY BELONGING TO JAMES I. MC CALL AND WIFE, CLEMMIE A. MC CALL, AND HEIRS OF C. O. BROWN AND WILLIS BROWN, LOCATED AT 1808 UMSTEAD AVENUE IN THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE FOR THE SMALL PARKS PROJECT I.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds as a fact that it is necessary to acquire certain property belonging to James I. McCall and wife, Clemmie A. McCall, and Heirs of C. O. Brown and Willis Brown, located at 1808 Umstead Avenue in the City of Charlotte, Mecklenburg County, for the purpose of establishing, maintaining and building a public park; and

WHEREAS, the City has in good faith undertaken to negotiate for the purchase of this property, but has been unable to reach an agreement with the owners for the purchase price;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte that, pursuant to Section 7.81, Chapter 713 of the 1965 Session Laws of North Carolina, as amended, and the North Carolina General Statutes 160-204 and 160-205, condemnation proceedings are hereby authorized to be instituted against the property of James I. McCall and wife, Clemmie A. McCall, and Heirs of C. O. Brown and Willis Brown, located at 1808 Umstead Avenue in the City of Charlotte, Mecklenburg County, under the procedures set forth in Article 2, Chapter 40 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, as amended.

RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE MUNICIPAL AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION COVERING PROJECTS TO BE COMPLETED UNDER THE TOPICS PROJECT DURING THE FIRST HALF OF 1972.

WHEREAS, the North Carolina State Highway Commission, the Federal Highway Administration and the City of Charlotte entered into an agreement providing for the implementation of a trial method for administering TOPICS through an Annual TOPICS Work Program in the City of Charlotte under Project 8.6100313, Mecklenburg County, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CHARLOTTE that a Supplemental Agreement proposed to make modifications in this agreement concerning TOPICS Improvements in which right-of-way acquisition if found to be necessary under the Annual TOPICS Work Program (Project 8.6100313), Mecklenburg County is approved, and the Mayor or City Manager and Clerk are authorized to sign and execute the contract.
