- (1) Class No. 335, Assistant to the Airport Manager is added and assigned to pay range 38, pay step A through F, inclusive.
- (2) Class No. 443, Procedure Writer, is added and assigned to pay range 33, pay steps A through F, inclusive.
- (3) Classes listed below are designated as Special Assignment Classes
Pay while on special assignments listed below shall be at the same pay step (A, B, C, D, E or F) attained in Class No. 568.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CONDEMNATION PROCEEDINGS FOR THE ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY BELONGING TO MUTUAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF CHARLOTTE, A CORPORATION, LOCATED AT 6001 THE PLAZA IN THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE FOR A SANITARY SEWER TO SERVE HAMPSHIRE HILLS SHOPPING CENTER.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds as a fact that it is necessary to acquire certain property belonging to Mutual Savings and Loan Association of Charlotte, a Corporation, located at 6001 The Plaza in the City of Charlotte for a perpetual easement and right of way for a sanitary sewer to serve Hampshire Hills Shopping Center; and

WHEREAS, the City has in good faith undertaken to negotiate for the purchase of this property, but has been unable to reach an agreement with the owners for the purchase price.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, that pursuant to Section 7.81 of the Charter of the City of Charlotte as amended by Chapter 216, 1967 Session Laws of North Carolina, and further amended by Chapter 384, 1969 Session Laws of North Carolina, condemnation proceedings are hereby authorized to be instituted against the property of Mutual Savings and Loan Association of Charlotte, a corporation, in the City of Charlotte, 6001 The Plaza, Mecklenburg County, under the procedures set forth in Article 9, Chapter 136 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, as amended; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$1,075.00, the amount of the appraised value of said property, is hereby authorized to be deposited in the office of the Clerk of Superior Court of Mecklenburg County, North Carolina, together with the filing of the Complaint and Declaration of Taking.
