
BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 828-X, THE 1973-74 BUDGET ORDINANCE, AMENDING REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR RELOCATION ASSISTANCE PAYMENTS IN THE CASE OF HOME FURNITURE COMPANY, ET AL.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1. That Section I, Schedule H (Urban Redevelopment Fund Expenditures) is hereby amended to add an appropriation of \$771,500 (Account No. 904.00.320), these funds will be used to provide relocation assistance payments in the case of the Home Furniture Company, et al.

Section 2. That Section II, Schedule H (Urban Redevelopment Fund Revenues) is hereby amended to add the following appropriations:

ORDINANCE 56


BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;




