with respect to the Zoning Ordinance


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE:

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING FUNDS TO MEET THE CITY'S OBLIGATION FOR THE DOWNTOWN  
URBAN RENEWAL PROJECT NO. A-3.

ORDINANCE NO. 85-X

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 828-X, THE 1973-74 BUDGET ORDINANCE, AMENDING REVENUES AND APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE OPERATION OF THE LEAA FUNDED POLICE YOUTH CORPS-EXPLORER SCOUT PROGRAM.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1. That Section I, Schedule A (General Fund Expenditures) is hereby amended to add an appropriation of \$3,868 for the operation of the LEAA funded Police Youth Corps-Explorer Scout Program.

Section 2. That Section II, Schedule A (General Fund Revenues) is hereby amended to increase the revenue estimate for Intergovernmental Revenue by \$3,868 representing the amount of the LEAA sub-grant award for the operation of the aforementioned project.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.
