Section 1. That, Chapter 23, Section 23-8, of the Code of the City of Charlotte is hereby amended by changing from R-6MF to 0-15 on the Official Zoning Map, City of Charlotte, N. C. the following described property:

BEGINNING at a point on the northernmost right-of-way line of Circle Avenue, said point being the southernmost corner of Lot 8, Block 3 as shown on a map of Colonial Heights recorded as shown below and being located 429.1 feet more or less northwest of the intersection of Circle Avenue and Chase Street; thence N.52-30E. 212.30 feet to a point; thence N.37-30W. 60.0 feet to a point; thence N.52-30E. 100.13 to a point; thence N.37-30W. 106.16 feet to a point on the southernmost right-of-way line of Colonial Avenue; thence S.53-30W. 320.57 feet along said right-of-way to a point; thence 52.33 feet along the radius of said right-of-way to a point on the northernmost right-of-way line of Circle Avenue; thence 83.10 feet along said right-of-way to the point of BEGINNING. The above described property being shown on a map recorded in Book 230, Page 20 in the Register of Deeds Office Mecklenburg County.




