

WHEREAS, weeds, grass and trash located on the premises at (address) 1237 Echo Glen Road has been found to be a nuisance by the Supervisor of Community Improvement Division of the Public Works Department, and the owner or those responsible for the maintenance of the premises has/have been ordered to remove the same, pursuant to Chapter 10, Article I, Section 10-9 of the Code of the City of Charlotte; and WHEREAS, the owner (s) or person (s) responsible for the maintenance of these premises has (have) failed to comply with the said order served by registered mail on September 30, 1975: and WHEREAS, The City Council, upon consideration of the evidence, finds as a fact that the aforesaid premises are being maintained in a manner which constitutes a public nuisance because of weeds, grass and trash NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, that the Supervisor of the Community Improvement Division, of the Public Works Department, is hereby ordered to cause removal of weeds, grass and trash from the aforesaid premises in the City of Charlotte, and that the City assess costs incurred, and this shall be a charge against the owner (owners), and shall be a lien against this property, all pursuant to Chapter 10, Article I, Section 10-9 of the Code of the City of Charlotte: Section 2. That this Ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.
