WHEREAS, it is hereby determined that it will be in the best interest of this Municipality to enter into a contract with the Board of Transportation pursuant to the provisions of G. S. 136-66.1 to provide for the mowing of the right-of-way on the State Highway System streets within the Municipality on a reimbursement basis and that the Municipality should enter into the agreement with the Board of Transportation concerning such work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the contract for mowing of the right-of-way on the State Highway System streets within the corporate limits of this Municipality be and it is hereby formally approved and the Mayor and Manager (or Clerk) of this Municipality are hereby empowered and directed to sign and execute the Agreement between this Municipality and the Board of Transportation.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CONDEMNATION PROCEEDINGS FOR THE ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY BELONGING TO TOM MATTOX AND WIFE, AZALEA MATTOX; RICHARD H. ROBERTSON, TRUSTEE; AND F. D. GOSSETT, LOCATED AT 2201 BOYER STREET (OFF I-85) IN THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE FOR THE SANITARY SEWER TRUNK TO SERVE WITHROW ROAD AND I-85 PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds as a fact that it is necessary to acquire certain property belonging to Tom Mattox and wife, Azalea Mattox; Richard H. Robertson, Trustee; and F. D. Gossett, located at 2201 Boyer Street (off I-85) in the City of Charlotte for a perpetual easement for a sanitary sewer trunk to serve Withrow Road and I-85 Project; and

WHEREAS, the City has in good faith undertaken to negotiate for the purchase of this property, but has been unable to reach an agreement with the owners for the purchase price.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, that pursuant to Section 7.81, Chapter 713 of the 1965 Session Laws of North Carolina, being the Charter of the City of Charlotte, as amended, and the authority granted in Chapter 160A-241 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, condemnation proceedings are hereby authorized to be instituted against the property of Tom Mattox and wife, Azalea Mattox; Richard H. Robertson, Trustee; and F. D. Gossett, located at 2201 Boyer Street (off I-85) in the City of Charlotte, under the procedures set forth in Article 9, Chapter 136 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, as amended; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$5,250.00, the amount of the appraised value of said property, is hereby authorized to be deposited in the office of the Clerk of Superior Court of Mecklenburg County, North Carolina, together with the filing of the Complaint and Declaration of Taking.
