ORDINANCE 478-X

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE 10 RELATING TO SPEED LIMITS REFERRED TO IN
CHAPTER 20, SECTION 86(c), OF THE CHARLOTTE CITY CODE

WHEREAS, it has been determined, upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation, that the speed limit on certain streets of the City of Charlotte, being a part of the State Highway System, should be revised or established.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte that:

Section 1: That Schedule 10 referred to in Chapter 20, Section 86(c) of the Charlotte City Code be amended by declaring speed limits on the following State Highway System Streets as described below:

A) The speed limit on Fairview Road Extension (SR 3686) from its junction with Sharon Road (SR 3600) eastward along Fairview Road Extension (SR 3686) to its junction with Carmel Road (SR 3611) be established at 45 MPH.

B) The speed limit on Carmel Road (SR 3686) from its junction with Carmel Road (SR 3611) eastward along Carmel Road (SR 3686) to its junction with Providence Road (NC 16) be established at 45 MPH.

Section 2: Section 1 of this ordinance shall become effective after the North Carolina Board of Transportation has passed a concurring ordinance adopting the speed limits so fixed by this ordinance and signs are erected giving notice of the authorized speed limit in accordance with N.C.G.S. 20-141(f).

AMENDING CHAPTER 10
ARTICLE II

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE II OF CHAPTER 10 OF THE CITY CODE
RELATIVE TO THE LITTER ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte,
North Carolina that:

Section 1. Section 10-22, subsection (b) of Article II
of Chapter 10 of the Code of the City of Charlotte is hereby
amended by adding the words "at least" in the third sentence
between the word "be" and the word "three".

Section 2. Section 10-22, subsection (b) of Article II
of the Code of the City of Charlotte is hereby further amended
by adding a semicolon between the word "collection" in the
second sentence and the period and by further adding the following
sentence between the semicolon and the period:

";provided that in the central business
district such collection shall also be
limited to a maximum of eight (8) refuse
receptacles or one (1) bulk container or
their equivalence with plastic bags with
closures per collection"

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon
adoption.


BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

ORDINANCE NO. 481

AMENDING CHAPTER 13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 31 OF CHAPTER 13 OF THE CHARLOTTE CITY CODE RELATING TO THE PUBLIC DISPLAY OF SEXUALLY EXPLICIT MATERIAL IN ESTABLISHMENTS FREQUENTED BY MINORS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte that:

Section 1. Chapter 13, Section 31 (b)(1) is hereby amended by the deletion of the following language at the end of said subsection, and by placing a period after the word "areas":

" . . . and the exposure of the female breast or breasts below the top of the nipple except those of infants."

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.

ORDINANCE NO. 482-X

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING FUNDS WITHIN THE GENERAL REVENUE SHARING TRUST FUND TO PROVIDE A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR IMPROVEMENTS AT ALLEN HILLS PARK.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte,
North Carolina;

Section 1. That the sum of \$25,000 is hereby transferred from Account 320.04 - Public Land Acquisition to Account 700.46 - Allen Hills Park Improvements. These funds will be used for the construction of sidewalk and a pedestrian bridge across Irwin Creek to the park site.
