
AN ORDINANCE ORDERING THE DEMOLITION AND REMOVAL OF THE DWELLING

2615 Duncan Ave. in the City of Charlotte in accordance
with the Housing Code of the City of Charlotte and Article 19, Part 6,
Chapter 160A of the General Statutes of North Carolina.


