

ORDINANCE NO. 443

AN ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY SUSPENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF
THE CITY CODE WITH RESPECT TO THE OPERATION OF TAXICABS.

WHEREAS, as a result of a strike by drivers and garage employees of Transit Management of Charlotte, Inc., the company is unable to operate the public transit system; and

WHEREAS, because of the hardships caused by the strike, the City desires to make arrangements with various taxicab companies to provide a limited amount of transportation service; and

WHEREAS, taxicab operations are regulated by Article 1, Chapter 19, of the City Code; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide a limited amount of transportation service through the use of taxicabs, it is necessary to temporarily suspend certain provisions of Article 1, Chapter 19, of the Code as an emergency measure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, that:

Section 1. The following sections and subsections of Article 1, Chapter 19, of the Code of the City of Charlotte are hereby temporarily suspended as they apply to transportation services provided for on behalf of the City of Charlotte only:

Sec. 19-26
Sec. 19-30
Sec. 19-77 (f)(2)
Sec. 19-77 (h)
Sec. 19-77 (j)
Sec. 19-77 (l).

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until repealed by the City Council, or until regular bus transportation service is resumed, whichever first occurs.
