AN ORDINANCE ORDERING THE REMOVAL OF AN ABANDONED MOTOR VEHICLE (s) LOCATED AT 3100 Block S. Tryon St. PURSUANT TO THE ARTICLE 10-29 OF THE CODE OF CHARLOTTE AND CHAPTER 160A-303 OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF NORTH CAROLINA.

WHEREAS, an abandoned motor vehicle (s) located at <u>3100 Block S</u>. <u>Tryon St.</u> in the City of Charlotte has been found by the Supervisor of the Community Improvement Division of the Public Works Department to be unsafe and to constitute a health hazard, and the owner (s) thereof has/have been ordered to remove said abandoned motor vehicle (s), all pursuant to the Article 10-29 of the Code of the City of Charlotte and Chapter 160A-303 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, and

WHEREAS, said owner (s) has/have failed to comply with said order served by registered mail on <u>March 1, 1979</u>: and,

WHEREAS, The City Council, upon consideration of the evidence, finds as a fact that the aforesaid vehicle (s) is unsafe and constitutes a health hazard;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by The City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, that the Supervisor of the Community Improvement Division of the Public Works Department is hereby ordered to cause removal of said abandoned motor vehicle (s) located at <u>3100 block S. Tryon St.</u>, in the City of Charlotte in accordance with Article 10-29 of the Code of the City of Charlotte and Chapter 160A-303 of the General Statutes of North Carolina.
