ORDINANCE NO. 636

An Ordinance Amending Chapter 23 of the City Code - Zoning Ordinance

An Ordinance Amending the City Code with respect to the Zoning Ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE:

Section 1. Chapter 23, "Zoning" of the Code of the City of Charlotte is hereby amended as follows:

- 1. Amend Article IV Area, Yard and Height Regulations Section 23-55 by adding a new paragraph (c) to be inserted following the existing paragraph (b) as follows:
 - (c) Non-residential structures located in the B-3 and B-3T Districts may be converted to residential purposes and in so doing are not subject to the dimensional requirements listed in paragraph (b) above provided that:
 - 1.) In no case shall the proposed conversion further encroach on yards or increase the existing floor area ratio;
 - 2.) No structure which will contain less than ten (10) multifamily dwelling units shall be eligible for use in accordance with this section; and
 - 3.) Only structures existing as of January 29, 1962 shall be eligible for use in accordance with this section.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.
